

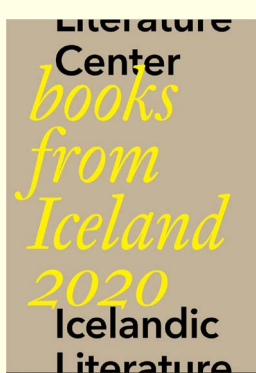
Literary greetings from Iceland!

The Icelandic Literature Center also has various grants at its disposal, such as translation grants for publishers abroad.

We want to point out especially that, in view of the coronavirus pandemic, the Nordic literature centres, NordLit, have formulated a joint policy that in 2020 Nordic translation grants will cover 50% of translation costs. [Read more.](#)


This step has been taken in order to encourage publishers around the world to continue to translate and publish Nordic fiction, academic works, books of general interest and books for children and young readers. The next deadline for [applications for translations from Icelandic](#) is 15 September.
