Icelandic Literature The Icelandic Literature Center is a government-funded office, founded in 2013. The role of the Center is to raise awareness of Icelandic literature, both in Iceland and abroad, and to promote its distribution through translation and travel grants.

## Foreign publishers may apply for

- Translation grants from Icelandic | open to foreign publishers wishing to publish a work translated from Icelandic
- Nordic translation grants from Icelandic | open only to Nordic publishers wishing to publish a work translated from Icelandic into other Nordic languages
- Travel grants | foreign publishers, Icelandic authors or organizations arranging events can apply for travel grants for Icelandic authors to promote their work abroad
- Sample grants | to produce sample translations of Icelandic literature

## Translators of Icelandic literature may apply for

• Residency and travel grants | open to translators of Icelandic literature

## **Grant application deadlines**

- Translation & Nordic translation grants | 15 February & 15 September
- Travel grants | 15 January, 15 May & 15 September
- Translators residential grants | 1 October
- Sample grants | 15 February & 15 September
